Trip to visit Stonehenge – Friday 28th March 2025

Dear Parents and carers,

On **Friday 28th March** we have planned a trip to **Stonehenge**. This will be a fantastic way for the children to end their studies on the Bronze Age.

We will be leaving school at approximately **10.45am**, so **your child needs to be in school by the usual time**. We will be leaving Stonehenge at **3.30pm** and anticipate being back at school for approximately **4pm**. Children will need to be in full school uniform.

Entry to Stonehenge itself is free but of course we need to pay for the coach, the cost of which will be **£7.98**; this is a voluntary contribution but if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Payment can be made via Arbor, which is now set up.
