We are delighted to inform you that we have organised an exciting Team Building Day for all Year 5 students at The Lake, H5 Adventure. This special day has been designed to develop teamwork, communication skills, and confidence in an enjoyable outdoor setting.

Date: Monday, 28th April

Time: Departure from school at 7:45am, return to school by 4:00pm

Location: The Lake, H5 Adventure

Cost: No payment required - fully covered by Sports Premium funding

During the day, students will participate in a range of engaging outdoor activities led by qualified instructors. Activities will include:

- **Canoeing** - Learning basic paddling techniques while working together on the water
- **Bushcraft** - Developing survival skills including fire-making and outdoor cooking
- **Shelter Building** - Collaborating to construct functional shelters using natural materials
- **Archery** - Practicing focus, precision, and supporting teammates
- **Orienteering** - Enhancing problem-solving and navigation skills in teams

Students will need to bring:

- A sunhat
- 1 drinking bottle
- Packed lunch
- Old footwear to wear when canoeing
- Coat
- Towel
- Full set of spare clothes and footwear as you may fall in the lake during the watersports

All safety equipment will be provided by H5 Adventure, and all activities will be conducted under expert supervision. The instructors are fully qualified, and comprehensive risk assessments have been carried out.
