Fairtrade Art

Collage

Collage describes both the technique and the resulting work of art in which pieces of paper, photographs, fabric and other material are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface.

Collage artists like **Clare Youngs** investigate and combine visual and tactile materials and processes to explore ideas.

When deciding what materials to put out, the focus can shift from warm colours to cool, shapes that encourage symmetry and repetition, shapes with straight edges, curved edges, softer torn edges, rough or smooth textures.



Key Vocabulary

Layering- putting one layer of paper on top of another.

Tearing- tearing the paper to create a rough edge and texture

Overlapping- in art is the placement of objects over one another to create the illusion of depth.

Select – to choose a variety of papers or fabric to create a collage

Texture- texture in art is the way something feels or looks like it feels in a work of art.

Combine- to put papers together to create a piece of art.

Infographics- are visual representations of information that use design elements to communicate a message quickly and clearly.
